## Current Account (% of GDP)



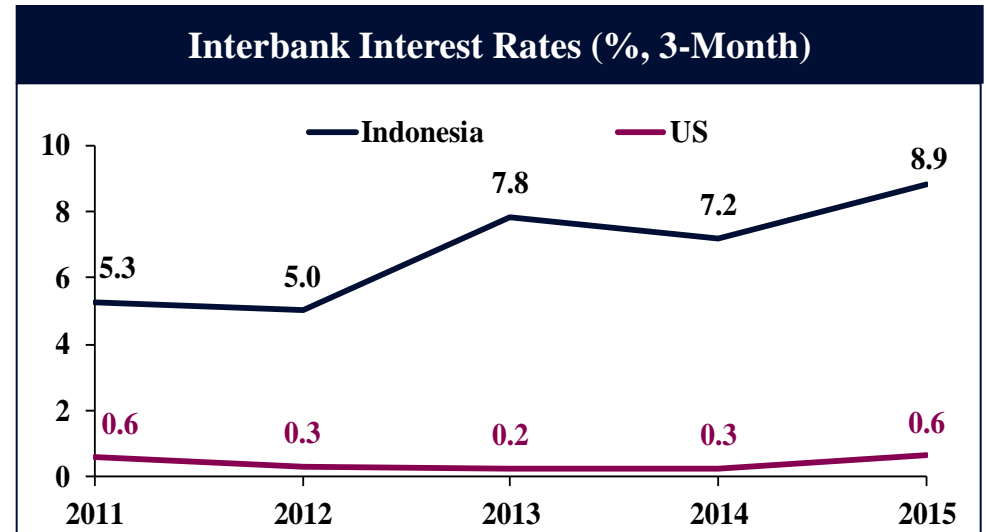
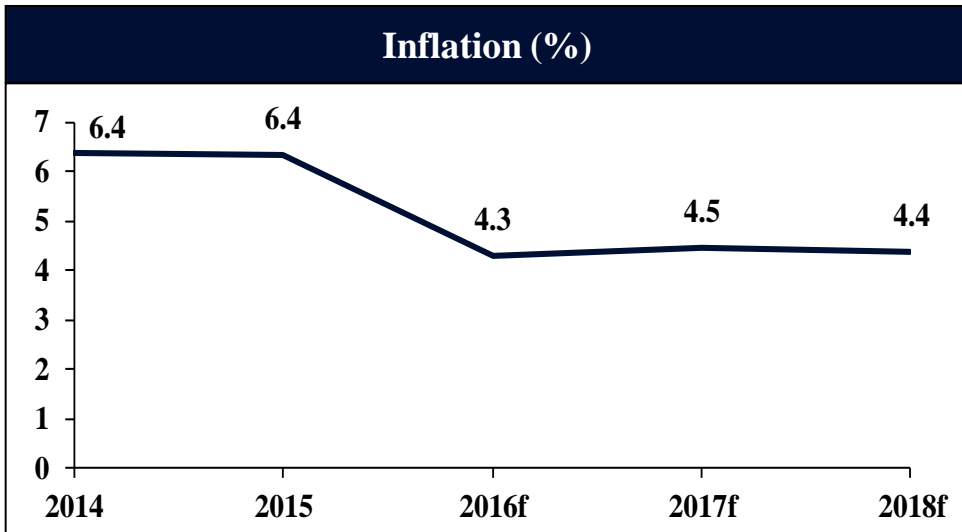
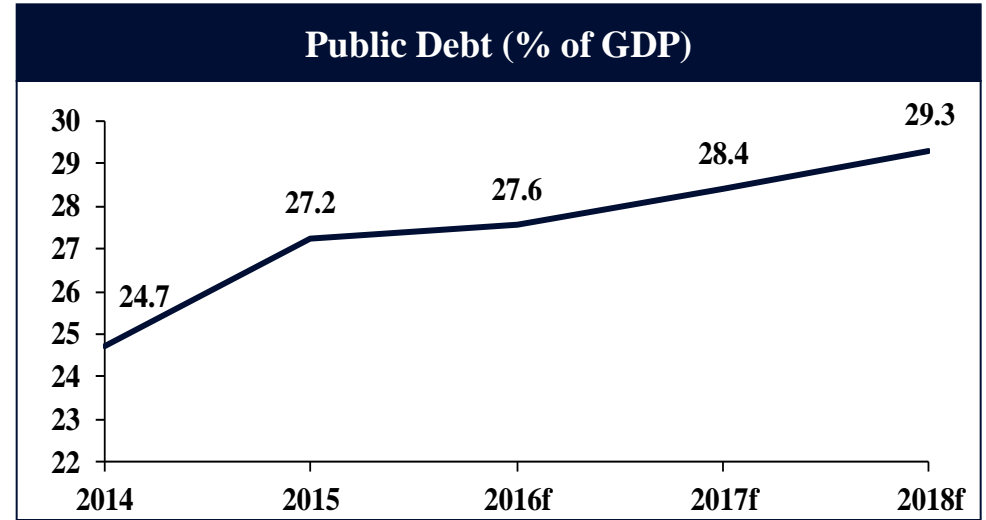
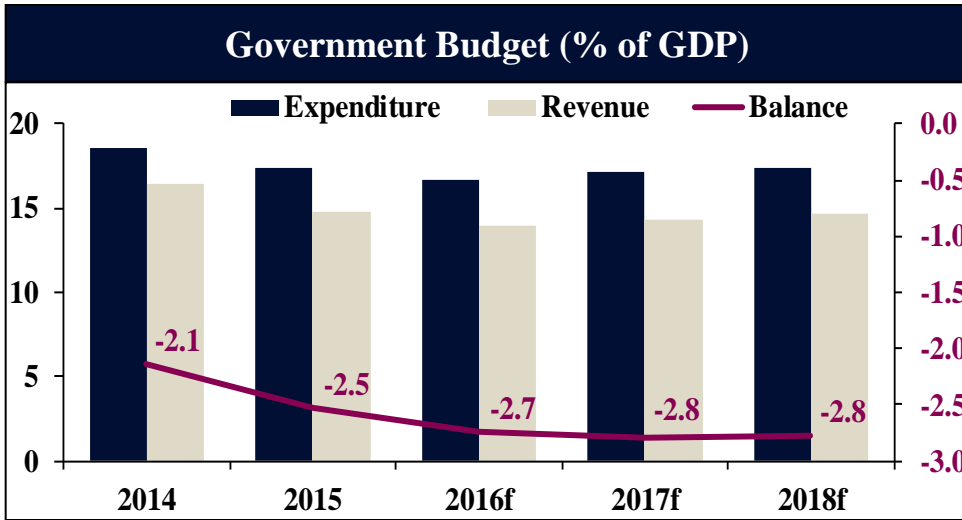
